Under Environmental Information Regulations (2004), I ask you to provide:

1. The addresses of all listed buildings in your area that have been altered or demolished without authorised consent between January 2015 into the present day.
2. Whether it was alteration or demolition that took place in each case.
3. The year in which each offence occurred.
4. Whether enforcement action was taken in each case.

RESPONSE

For the purposes of this request the Council does not hold information, nor is aware of exhaustively, all unauthorised alteration or demolition works to Listed Buildings within the Borough.

In part consideration of this request, please see below that details the unauthorised demolitions that the Council is aware of during this period.
