Q2a – 3b) The Council does not hold this information.

Building Control gateways are part of the Building Safety Act for higher risk buildings, they are not governed by, or register by, the Local Authority or private registered building control approvers.

High risk buildings are governed by the Building Safety Regulator (BSR) direct, and they hold information relating to Gateway 2 and 3 building regulations applications.

Local Authorities may be asked by the BSR to be part of the multi-disciplinary team (MDT) and assist with plan checking and inspections, and this request would then be recorded by the Local Authority, but the Council doesn't have the requirement at the time of this request to record the Gateway status.

In this respect the Council can confirm that it has not received any requests from the BSR in relations to Gateway 2 or 3.
