I am requesting the following information regarding the adoption status of Ash Grove, Standish, Wigan. WN6 0DZ:

1. A copy of the official adoption plan showing the exact extent of the adopted highway, including footpaths, verges, or adjacent land.

The information you have requested is exempt from disclosure under Section 21(1)(b) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This section applies where the information is reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means. Information is to be taken to be reasonably accessible to the applicant if it is information which the public authority or any other person is obliged by or under any enactment to communicate (otherwise than by making the information available for inspection) to members of the public on request, whether free of charge or on payment. In this case, the information you are seeking is already available through [Private streets](#) at a cost of £12.

2. The date the road (or sections of it) was adopted.
3. The legal mechanism used for the adoption (e.g., Section 38 Agreement or Section 228 of the Highways Act 1980).
4. A copy of any Section 38 agreement(s) or adoption certificates related to the road.
5. Details of any correspondence, notices, or public records concerning the adoption process for this road.
6. Any plans or maps used by the council to determine the boundary between public highway and private land in this area.
