Regarding all complaints and disputes related to The.Coffee.Collective.Ltd trading at Pennington Marina, WN7 4GB.

Response

The Council confirms it holds the information requested.

Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 provides an exemption if the information requested constitutes personal data and if one of three conditions is satisfied. The first condition under section 40(3A)(a) is satisfied if disclosure would breach any of the Data Protection Principles in UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The first data protection principle is that personal data processing must be lawful. The only possible lawful bases for disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 would be consent or legitimate interests. The Council does not have the person's consent to disclose this information and would not seek it. The Council has no legitimate interest in disclosing what is sensitive personal data to a third party and any third party's legitimate interests would be outweighed by the data protection and privacy rights of the person. Therefore, the Council confirms that it has withheld the requested information using the exemption available at section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
