

We request disclosure of the following information in relation to the proposed or actual use of public funds for capital contributions, grants, loans or financial support to commercial operators or tenants specifically the proposed cinema and leisure operation at The Galleries/Fettlers scheme as part of the Wigan town centre redevelopment or regeneration scheme (including, but not limited to, The Galleries/Fettlers redevelopment):

- 1. Details of any financial assistance offered, proposed, or agreed with any commercial cinema and/or leisure operators or tenants, including:
 - a. The names of recipients (companies or brands);
 - b. The amount and nature of the funding (e.g. capital contribution, grant, loan or other support);
 - c. The purpose and justification for such funding;
 - d. Any conditions or obligations attached to the receipt of the funds.
- Internal and external reports, assessments, or legal advice related to the justification for providing such funding to commercial cinema and leisure operators/tenants.
- 3. Any subsidy control assessments (including compliance statements under the Subsidy Control Act 2022) undertaken in relation to the provision of any such public funding.

- 4. Whether any such financial support was subject to:
 - a. A competitive process;
 - b. An open tender or application procedure.
- 5. Minutes or summaries of council meetings, cabinet decisions, or officer decisions where such funding was discussed or approved.
