

I am making a Freedom of Information request for the following information. (Please note when reference is made to appointeeship, this includes deputyships as well as appointeeships).

1. Currently how many individuals is the authority acting as an appointee for?

There are currently 88 Deputyship Clients we are acting for.

2. Currently how many of these have savings over £16,000?

67 clients have over £16,000.

3. What is the current combined sum of savings over £16,000 for all those individuals the authority is an appointee for. (E.g. if there are 2 people, one with £19,000 and the other with £16,500 then the sum is £3,500)

£5,693,826.99

4. Of those with savings over £16,000, how many live in supported accommodation?

23 clients live in Supported Accommodation.

5. What is the current combined sum of savings over £16,000 for those living in supported accommodation?

£1,025,730.32 (note this is subject to meeting tax liabilities and other outstanding debts)

6. For the financial year April 2024 to April 2025 what was the total amount of fees the authority received as a result of acting as appointees?

£94,925.11 Deputyship Income as per Practice Direction B Remuneration of Public Authority Deputies.
