I am currently undertaking research into the annual costs incurred by councils, and therefore taxpayers, for statutory fire safety compliance checks across social housing stock. In particular, I am interested in the costs associated with Regulation 10 fire door checks and emergency lighting inspections.

Please could you confirm the following:

1. Regulation 10 Fire Door Checks

- The total annual cost to the council for providing Regulation 10 fire door inspection/check services across all social housing stock.
- If the total annual cost is not available, please provide the cost per door per year.

2. Emergency Lighting Checks (Flick Tests)

- The total annual cost to the council for carrying out regular emergency lighting flick tests in accordance with the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 across all social housing stock.
- If the total annual cost is not available, please provide the cost per block, per building, or per unit per year (whichever is most appropriate).

RESPONSE

£335,000.00 annual cost under a 3-year contract.

We auto test our emergency lighting through a wireless mess portal for our high-rise blocks. This is currently under a previous procured 5-year parts and labour warranty which expires in 2029.

The cost of the low-rise blocks is incorporated in the building periodic testing cycle and annual inspection and difficult to quantify. However, an estimate of £125,000.00 per annum is based on apportioned cost.
