1. Can you please tell me what controls, restrictions, mitigations & monitoring is in place for outdoor music events held at:- (1) Leigh sports village and (2) Robin park - in relation to noise & what measures are used to protect the wider public from unwanted exposure during these events.
2. Can you tell me if there are specific management plans in place at these venues and what conditions are imposed.

Response

When considering applications or plans to host outdoor music events at both LSV and Robin Park the first consideration would be the frequency of these events. Generally reducing the frequency is the best way to minimise the impact on the surrounding areas. The frequency for large outdoor music events is currently annual. The event would usually be operational for a period of 3 to 5 days. When planning events of this significant size a full noise management plan is required from the Safety Advisory Group (SAG) as part of the application.

The specific management plan is required from the SAG to control sounds levels associated with the event, this is usually monitored by an independent company but can also be monitored by environmental health as the statutory enforcing agency.
