Request

As a resident of Lane Head in Lowton we have an ongoing issue with HGV traffic traveling southbound on the A579 Winwick Lane. This is a weight restricted lane and as a deterrent to track and prosecute repeat offenders we were told Wigan council had erected a Traffic camera at the junction of the A572 and A579 to collect the number plate details of HGVs illegally using this route.

Can you please advise the number of successful and failed prosecutions as a result of this camera being in place.

Response

4811 PCNs have been issued since November 2024 (i.e. when moving traffic enforcement started on Winwick Lane)

3833 of the above cases have been paid in full and the cases are now closed.

256 appeals have been accepted and the cases are now closed.

722 are still live in the system and therefore processing through the statutory process of the issue of a PCN.
