Draw a.....

Number of pupils: 1+

<u>Purpose</u>: Learn/revise positions- top/middle/bottom/right/left and shapes (or other items of vocabulary)

<u>Equipment</u>: A small board each (and also the use of a class board if you wishthough this isn't necessary)

<u>Extension</u>: If the pupil is able then you can also use above/below/in the middle of, big/small and more shapes.

<u>Note:</u> This is quite a demanding vocabulary load but pupils usually manage very well.

- 1. If the prepositions and the shape names are new then introduce the prepositions first.
- 2. Show right/left on the board, check understanding by saying the side and the pupil points to the correct side. The pupil then tells you right/left and s/he checks that you have pointed to the correct side.
- 3. Introduce top/middle and bottom in the same way.
- 4. Combine all these and check understanding as before.
- 5. Introduce the shapes.
- 6. Ask the pupil to draw a triangle (or another shape) in a part of the board e.g. 'Draw a triangle in the top right corner.'
- 7. Check understanding and drawing is correct, and continue with another instruction e.g. 'Draw a circle in the bottom left corner.'
- 8. When their board is complete and correct they then give you the instructions to follow.
- 9. When this is completed and they can use all the items of vocabulary correctly then introduce other words or move onto another topic.
- 10. Revise the next lesson.
