A recorder belongs to the wind family.



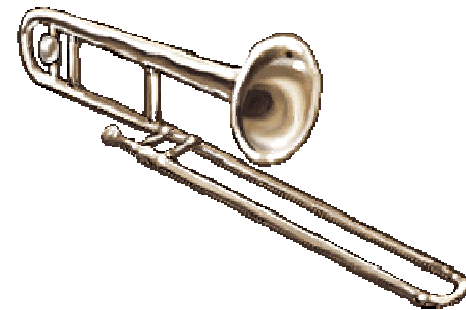
This is a harp.

A mandolin belongs to the string family.



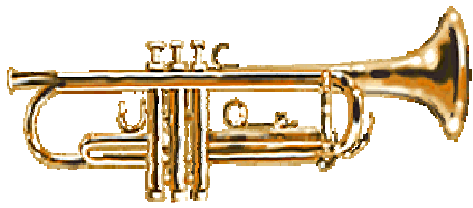
This is a cornet
