- Support available 24 hours a day.

The support team

Daily support is provided both on a one to one basis and collectively between the people living at Cavendish Road. The team at Cavendish road is made up of both male and female enablers, with varying qualities and qualifications, creating a vibrant customer-centric working and living environment. There is also a waking night member of staff and sleep in support. The support is suitable for both males and females aged between 20 and 40, with a range of complex needs.

Location

Cavendish road is situated by the railway line running through Urmston and is set back from the road in its own grounds with private off road parking. Cavendish road is close to all local amenities such as shops, supermarket, church, pubs, local market and medical centre. Urmston train station and bus routes are within close proximity, providing easy access for travel to Manchester city centre and the Trafford. Cavendish Road is ideally suited for anyone wanting independent living within a social group.

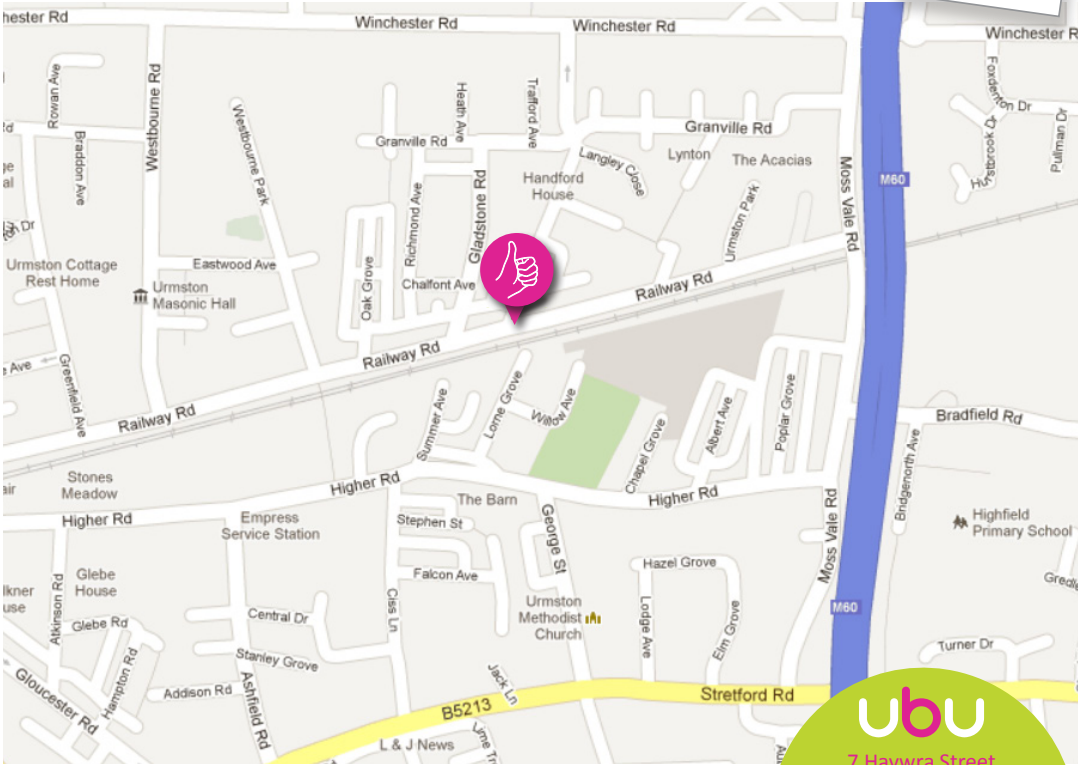
