Leigh Film Society are building a community cinema at Spinners Mill. Leigh a grade 2 * listed building. Leigh Film Society is a registered Charity, a national award-winning film organisation run entirely by volunteers. We use film screening projects to fight against social isolation, create opportunities for young people and support community cohesion.

This community cinema is made up of many strands that will introduce a young audience to the world of film and the therapeutic benefit that cinema therapy offers. The idea came from Leigh Film being asked by Wigan council and local community groups to screen films for young adults with autism, primary schools, young carers and their loved ones, asylum seekers and refugees. We promote culture and community cinema inclusive of everyone in society with no exceptions. This community project will reach out to young people who find attending a multiplex challenging. For them we will provide a safe and welcoming environment. We also plan to utilise the space for other community groups to use for their own development and events.
