## Project Overview

Leigh Spinners is an iconic Grade II* listed building of national and local importance. It is a much-loved landmark and tells the story of industry in the first half of the $20^{\text {th }}$ century.

Leigh Spinners is still owned by the family that founded the mill, which is in part, now leased from Leigh Building Preservation Trust (LBPT). The Trust has acquired the freehold of the property in order to develop the whole site, with works currently undertaken on Mill Two. The Trust currently lease Mill Two to a variety of businesses, CIC's and sports tenants.

The Trust are determined to tell the next part of the Leigh Spinners story and are committed to embed a culture of environmental improvement within the mill and to be a trusted and influential environmental organisation in everything we do.

The trust has a group of volunteers who tend to the grounds and outside of the mill's buildings. It would be great if commercial companies would support these willing volunteers making sure the Mill is environmentally friendly
