Project Overview

Wigan Youth Zone is a charity which inspires and empowers the next generation to reach their full potential - this is achieved through core services (accessible for anyone aged 8-19, up to 25 with SEND) and specialised targeted projects. Over the course of the past ten years, the charity has generated over £40m worth of social value for the Borough.

What support is needed:

Wigan Youth Zone is fully reliant on the year-round support of the community to maintain its extensive range of services. The most meaningful support is:

- Long-term business partnerships with robust impact and social value reporting:
- Employee fundraising; payroll giving; joint events; and 'thinking outside the box'.
- Work experience/apprenticeship opportunities for young job seekers aged 16-24.
- Team building away days at the Youth Zone.
- Sponsoring parts of our charity's operations.
- In-kind goods/services:
- Accredited training opportunities for young job seekers aged 16-24 (e.g. CSCS card).
- Financial skills for life and work training courses for all ages.
- Building maintenance services.
- Regular volunteering i.e. Mentoring young people, once a week for up to six months.

What difference it would make to our project?

Significant. Wigan Youth Zone currently provides support for over 5,000 young people a year – over half of which come from the top 20% most deprived parts of the area.
