Wigan's Deal is a pioneering approach which is helping people live rich and valued lives, connected to their local communities, increasing resilience and independence. We have seen that this way of working reduces dependence on formal health and social care services making a significant contribution to financial sustainability.

We have moved away from traditional ways of working which concentrate on what service users can't do, instead focusing on finding out what they enjoy doing, what they want to do and connecting them with existing opportunities in the community.

Our Deal training has played a key role in supporting staff to work in an asset based way and has been widely recognised as an exemplar. Feedback from participants has been outstanding. As part of the training we will share with you our exciting journey of change. We will explain about the Deal principles, which we have used as part of our wider programme of service transformation.
