





Impact of PSR on Communities



5.9% reduction in A+E attendance rate for over 75's



Best in the North West at getting people home from hospital quickly



78% of residents supported by our reablement service require no further ongoing support



Healthy Life Expectancy for women achieved the England avg for the first time. Fastest improving in GM for Men



5% Reduction in domestic abuse incidents. Repeat rate down 7%



Repeat missing adults reduced from 51% to 10%



52% reduction in first time entrants to Youth Justice System
