

They have £5,000 to spend on young people's ideas.

They're looking for interesting, imaginative ideas that will help young people and your area. You might want to get a new kit for your sports group, run some training or a workshop for other young people, get some publicity materials or put on a play with a positive message.

If you're aged 8-19, you can apply for up to £500 to spend on your idea.

Payment of funding will not be received directly to the organisation and it should be organised that payment for goods/services should be invoiced directly to Wigan Council. Details will be given if your application is successful.




