Wigan Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 129 of the Highways Act 1980 and all the enabling powers being satisfied that a Gating Order would be beneficial for tackling crime and anti-social behaviour to that area of Leigh hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the Wigan Borough (Alleyway to the Rear of 30 to 40 Bradshawgate, Leigh) Gating Order 2007 and shall come into operation on
- 2. The public right of way along the alleyway to the Rear of 30 to 40 Bradshawgate, Leigh is restricted at all times.
- 3. Nothing in article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
 - a) all owners and occupiers of premises adjacent to or adjoining the passageways listed in Article 2
 - b) persons using the highway in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the said length of highway of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable

or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or any other telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984

- c) person using the highway for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes
- d) Council officers on business
- e) Persons using the highway with the permission or at the direction of the duly authorised officer of the Council
- 4. There are no alternative routes applicable in this instance.
- 5. The maintenance and operation of the gate will be the responsibility of the Alleygating Co-ordinator
- 6. The conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Highways Act 1980 have been complied with for the purposes of making the Order
