NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

THE WIGAN BOROUGH (PASSAGEWAYS AT RAILWAY ROAD, TWIST LANE, MILTON STREET AND FAIRHURST STREET, LEIGH) GATING ORDER 2007

Notice is hereby given that the Wigan Borough Council intends to make the above Gating Order under Section 129 of the Highways Act 1980 (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers

The effect of the Order will be to restrict at all times, subject to certain exemptions, the public right of way over the passageways:-

- i. to the rear of 138 Twist Lane and at the side of 62 Milton Street
- ii. between 46 and 48 Milton Street
- iii. to the rear of 115 Railway Road and at the side of 2 Milton Street
- iv. to the rear of 127 Railway Road and at the side of 58 Fairhurst Street
- v. between 16 and 18 Fairhurst Street
- vi. to the rear of 150 Twist Lane and to the side of 2 Fairhurst Street

Details of the exemptions and alternative routes along with full particulars of the passageways affected are set out in the proposed Order shown in the Schedule.

Any representations or objections to the Order must be in writing to the Director of Legal and Property Services, Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan WN1 1YN by 28th September 2007. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

(Proposed Gating Order)

THE WIGAN BOROUGH (PASSAGEWAYS AT RAILWAY ROAD, TWIST LANE, MILTON STREET AND FAIRHURST STREET, LEIGH) GATING ORDER 2007

Wigan Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 129 of the Highways Act 1980 and all the enabling powers being satisfied that a Gating Order would be beneficial for tackling crime and anti-social behaviour to that area of Leigh hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Wigan Borough (Passageways at Railway Road, Twist Lane, Milton Street and Fairhurst Street, Leigh) Gating Order 2007 and shall come into operation on
2. The public right of way along the following passageways is restricted at all times:-
 - i. to the rear of 138 Twist Lane and at the side of 62 Milton Street
 - ii. between 46 and 48 Milton Street
 - iii. to the rear of 115 Railway Road and at the side of 2 Milton Street
 - iv. to the rear of 127 Railway Road and at the side of 58 Fairhurst Street
 - v. between 16 and 18 Fairhurst Street
 - vi. to the rear of 150 Twist Lane and to the side of 2 Fairhurst Street
3. Nothing in article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
 - a) all owners and occupiers of premises adjacent to or adjoining the passageways listed in Article 2
 - b) persons using the highway in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the said length of highway of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or any other telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984
 - c) persons using the highway for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes
 - d) Council officers on business
 - e) persons using the highway with the permission or at the direction of the duly authorised officer of the Council
4. Alternative routes are available via Railway Road, Thirlmere Street, Milton Street, Fairhurst Street, Findlay Street and Twist Lane.
5. The maintenance and operation of the gate will be the responsibility of the Council.
