How places were allocated

Holy Family RC Primary School, Boothstown is a Voluntary Aided School.

All applications were processed using the 'equal preference' system as explained in the 'Applying for a Reception class place 2026/27 booklet'.

Tie Breaker

Places in criterion 7.3 were allocated to the 9 pupils living nearest to the school. The last of these places was allocated to a pupil living 1.007 miles from the school.

Applications received after the closing date of 15 January 2026 are deemed to be late and only considered after applications received on time. Changes of preferences received after the closing date are also classed as late applications.
