How places were allocated

St Michael's CE Primary School, Howe Bridge is a Voluntary Aided School.

All applications were processed using the 'equal preference' system as explained in the 'Applying for a Reception class place 2026/27 booklet'.

Criterion 1. Looked after children and previously looked after children.
Places offered under this criterion – 0

Criterion 2. Brother or sister to pupils who will be in attendance at the school at the time of admission.
Places offered under this criterion – 9

Criterion 3. Child participation in worship in an Anglican Church, i.e. a Church of England Church.
Places offered under this criterion – 7

Criterion 4. Child participation in worship at another Christian church.
Places offered under this criterion – 0

Criterion 5. Children whose social circumstances mean that their needs can only be met at this school.
Places offered under this criterion – 0

Criterion 6. Children whose medical circumstances mean that their needs can only be met at this school.
Places offered under this criterion – 0

Criterion 7. Distance from school.
Places offered under this criterion - 13

Tie Breaker

Places in criterion 7 were allocated to the 13 pupils living nearest to the school. The last of these places was allocated to a pupil living 0.259 miles from the school.

Applications received after the closing date of 15 January 2026 are deemed to be late and only considered after applications received on time. Changes of preferences received after the closing date are also classed as late applications.
