

# Lowton Junior and Infant School

This document explains how places were allocated at the school for admission to reception class in September 2022.

## How places were allocated

Lowton Junior and Infant School is a Foundation School.

All applications were processed using the 'equal preference' system as explained in the 'Admissions to Primary Schools 2022/23 booklet'.

Places offered - 0

### Criterion 1.

Looked after children and previously looked after children.  
Places offered under this criterion - 0

### Criterion 2.

Children who appear to the Governing Body to have been in state care as a result of being adopted. A child is regarded as having been in state care in a place outside of England if they were accommodated by a public authority, a religious organisation or any other provider of care whose sole purpose is to benefit society  
Places offered under this criterion - 0

### Criterion 3.

Children whose older brothers or sisters attend the school and will still be there at the time of Admission.  
Places offered under this criterion - 11

### Criterion 4.

Children who live closest to the school.  
Places offered under this criterion - 19

## Tie Breaker

Places in criterion 4 were allocated to the 19 pupils living nearest to the school. The last of these places was allocated to a pupil living 1.911 miles from the school.

Applications received after the closing date of 15 January 2022 are deemed to be late and only considered after applications received on time. Changes of preference received after the closing date are also classed as late applications.
