Update: Consultation to reduce school places in the Shevington area

On Monday 13th June we provided you with the above consultation document. This document explained that Shevington Community Primary School was pending an in inspection outcome.

We can now confirm the outcome of the inspection is that Shevington Community Primary has been judged '**Outstanding**'.

Following queries regarding option 4 we would like to clarify that this is an option to

- Close either Shevington Primary or Shevington Vale School 'in name'
- Use the buildings at either site to accommodate children from both schools. This would mean children from both Shevington Vale and Shevington Primary will come together in one school utilising one of the school sites.

It is important to note that parents can submit their own options on the consultation document. All submissions will be considered.
