

Public Spaces Protection Order

Wigan Council is looking to introduce a boroughwide Public Spaces Protection Order which, if implemented, will look at greater powers for Environmental Enforcement Officers and promote responsible dog ownership.

The following proposals are being considered by Wigan Council and look to seek as many views as possible to guide us in the best way.

A Public Space Protection Order (PSPO) was created by the 2014 Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act to deal with any nuisances or problems in a particular area that affects the local community's quality of life. A PSPO imposes conditions on how an area can be used with the aim of preventing anti-social behaviour in public spaces.
