Build a robust information system, so families can access information about 'what's on' and Start Well Centres can share this information with families and professionals.

Opportunities

Use the variety of places in Marsh Green to offer the best support, i.e. possible use of the medical centre, library and St Barnabus church in Marsh Green, and the role of Fur Clemt Community Café.

To support the local community to improve the environment surrounding the Start Well Centre in Westfield, with a particular focus on the nearby field, this has been identified as a 'dangerous environment' to the local community.

To work with local sport clubs to develop engagement opportunities with dads, children and families.

To make links with tenants and resident associations.
