Who is this course for:

This course is for anyone claiming universal credit or ESA (WRAG) and aged over 19 who wants to embark upon a career in construction.

What will I learn? (Course aim and learning outcomes)

Aim: To provide an introduction to joinery and carpentry, painting and decorating, tiling and bricklaying.

The course is a first step for anyone wanting to learn basic construction skills with a view to moving on to gain a CSCS card to work on construction sites.

The course will also help learners to develop basic problem solving, teamwork and communication skills to support them into work.

How will I know I have achieved?	Your tutor will develop an individual learning plan which will outline your goals and targets to achieve employment. They will record what you have achieved over the course, and you will complete practical tasks and workbook tasks to complete the course. You will also know if you have achieved if you leave the course feeling more confident in your future, with a clearer action plan and steps to move on! We will also help you complete an action plan and identify your strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats to succeeding.
How will I be assessed?	There is no exam. We will use practical tasks in our construction skills workshop to assess learner's basic construction skills. We will also use workbooks for the
