Who is this course for?

The course is for any adults aged 19+ who would like to develop their understanding of Maths and gain a recognised qualification.

What will I learn? (Course aim and learning outcomes)

Overall aim for the course: To build confidence and skills in maths.

Examples of expected learning outcomes

- to develop efficient methods in the 4 rules,
- to find fractions of quantities, including working out prices of items in a sale.
- to be familiar with metric measures relating to length, weight and capacity, for example, metres, grams and litres.
- to learn the difference between perimeter, area, and volume

What previous experience or qualifications will I need?	No previous experience is necessary for this course.
How will I know I have achieved?	Your tutor will develop an individual learning plan which will record what you have achieved over the course.
How will I be assessed?	Your tutor will plan assessment activities that will capture how you are progressing in the each of the topic areas. There is also an exam at the end of the course and a recognised qualification if you pass.









Where can I go next?	There is the opportunity for progression between each of the levels eg L1 to L2.
	There is also the opportunity to study FS English, either after completing the Maths course or at the same time.
What do I need to bring?	It would be good if you could bring a pen
	and notebook to your first session, but not essential. All other resources will be provided.
What is the cost?	The course is free of charge.
Will I need childcare?	This course will run term time only
Where is the course venue?	The course will be held at Wigan Life
	Centre. There is no access to drinks or snacks so you may wish to bring a bottle of water with you.
