<p>Course Title and level: Functional Skills Maths Entry Level, Level 1 and Level 2</p>	<p>Number of Weeks: 36</p> <p>Number of hours per week: 2</p>
<p>Who is this course for?</p> <p><i>The course is for any adults aged 19+ who would like to develop their understanding of Maths and gain a recognised qualification.</i></p> <p><i>“The course gave me a new confidence with Maths, that I had never had before. <p>What will I learn? (Course aim and learning outcomes)</p> <p><i>Overall aim for the course: To build confidence and skills in maths.</i></p> <p><i>Examples of expected learning outcomes</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>to develop efficient methods in the 4 rules,</i> • <i>to find fractions of quantities, including working out prices of items in a sale.</i> • <i>to be familiar with metric measures relating to length, weight and capacity, for example, metres, grams and litres.</i> • <i>to learn the difference between perimeter, area, and volume</i> 	
<p>What previous experience or qualifications will I need?</p>	<p><i>No previous experience is necessary for this course.</i></p>
<p>How will I know I have achieved?</p>	<p><i>Your tutor will develop an individual learning plan which will record what you have achieved over the course.</i></p>
<p>How will I be assessed?</p>	<p><i>Your tutor will plan assessment activities that will capture how you are progressing in the each of the topic areas.</i></p> <p><i>There is also an exam at the end of the course and a recognised qualification if you pass.</i></p>

<p>Where can I go next?</p>	<p><i>There is the opportunity for progression between each of the levels eg L1 to L2.</i></p> <p><i>There is also the opportunity to study FS English, either after completing the Maths course or at the same time.</i></p>
<p>What do I need to bring?</p>	<p><i>It would be good if you could bring a pen and notebook to your first session, but not essential. All other resources will be provided.</i></p>
<p>What is the cost?</p>	<p><i>The course is free of charge.</i></p>
<p>Will I need childcare?</p>	<p><i>This course will run term time only</i></p>
