

## Children mentioned in the Leigh Union Minute Books

The index produced below gives the names and basic case details of children from the Leigh area associated with the Leigh Union. These are children who may have spent time in the workhouse, or were in the care of the Board of Guardians of the Poor.

The names are given in date order, and include details from associated minutes that may be of assistance to local and family historians.
