

# Edward Hall, notes and transcripts for 'Shorter English Diaries, 1676-1910'

#### **EHC/100**

In the late 1930s, around the time the Oxford University Press were publishing his books on Miss Weedon, Eward Hall embarked on a new project. This was to edit and publish extracts from some of the diaries in his collection.

His working title was 'Shorter English Diaries, 1676 to 1910'. However, work on the project was interrupted by the Second World War and did not resume until 1944 when he had returned to the UK after serving overseas.

He was given the post of Rail Transport Officer at Gloucester station, a sinecure of a job which gave him time to continue his research. However, by the autumn of 1945 he had been promoted to the rank of Squadron Leader with the much more onerous job of Officer Commanding an RAF camp at Folkstone.

Apart from some drafts and working papers there is nothing to show that his efforts ever came to fruition. These working papers form part of the Edward Hall collection and are grouped under the overall reference EHC/100. The individual papers are listed below. Numbers given in the listing – such as EHC/67 – refer to the catalogue reference of the surviving diary, where this exists in the Edward Hall Collection.

Early draft of a transcript, with explanatory notes, of part of George Folliot's diary (1765-66) by Edward Hall, c.1945

#### EHC/67/HR/ 2

Transcript of part of George Folliot's diary (1765-66), with explanatory notes, by Edward Hall, corrected and better typed version of EHC/67/ HR/1, c.1945

#### EHC/67/HR/ 3

Original and copy of a letter from A J Hawkes to Edward Hall relating to the loan of a George Folliot diary (probably the 1773 -1774) for an exhibition in Wigan Library, June 1944

#### EHC/67/HR/ 4

Three copies of the explanatory note displayed with the George Folliot diary, exhibited in Wigan Library, 1944

Two copies of a document headed 'The Diary of George Folliot, New York Merchant – Introduction', written by W E Michington, Senior Lecturer in History at the University College of Swansea. Possibly intended as an introduction to the published version of the diary on microfilm, undated, but possibly later than the second half of the 1940s since it mentions E Hall's gift of the diary to Wigan Library
