It was presented to a British Soldier (Sergeant [BLANK], Wigan Drill Hall), during the Burmese Rebellion of 1931, by a Burmese, whose name appears in pencil on the last leaf, as a reward for saving his life. It was acquired by the Wigan Public Library in May 1934, by purchase from Mr. T. J. Cheetham, 14 Moores Street, Wigan."
