Notebook of Alfred Griffiths, private soldier, First World War	Pocket note-book belong to Alfred Griffiths of Platt Bridge, who served as a private soldier during the First World War, fought and was injured at the Battle of the Somme and died of his wounds in 1916 in a military hospital in Brighton. The note-book contains some diary entries, observations on campaigns and military actions, details of friends and soldiers, including their deaths or injuries, details of kit and possessions and a poem, possibly written by Griffiths, entitled, "A Lonely Sentry". Accompanying the volume are photocopied documents including a newspaper obituary, memorial, a letter to his wife Emily, and an account published in "The Christian World" by a clergyman who spoke to Mrs Griffiths on her journey to Brighton to see her husband with their eleventh child; Alfred died before she arrived at Brighton.
