Wigan Canal Boat Records

Lists produced by Professor Timothy Peters on behalf of the Waterways Archives and Wigan Council Archives Service.

The volumes give details of those boats registered with the Wigan authorities and operating on canals in the Wigan area between 1879 and 1943. Each boat was inspected to ascertain its general condition and state of repair.
