Damhouse, Historical Manor House with Tea Room





Damhouse, Astley Hall Drive, Astley, Manchester, Greater Manchester, M29 7TX

Damhouse is a Grade II* listed Manor House in 17acres of Woodland and houses a Tea Room, offices and function rooms. The historical part of the building remains as it was in the 1500s. On the Heritage Open Days there will be access to the top floor of the building, which has a short passage long gallery with many ancient timbers. There will be information displays, talks and tours throughout the weekend.

Rev Alison Brown is the perfect person to guide you through both the history of the Church and the local history (Think -The Vicar of Dibley). The tower will be open for anyone who can manage the winding stairs (54 steps). Our gorgeous church welcomes photographers where they can come and set up and click away. Also any artists are welcome to bring along their easels and paints. Come and enjoy the lighting that bursts through the stained glass windows. You will not be disappointed.

St Peter's Church. Firs Lane

St Peter's Church is situated in Leigh Greater Manchester and is a Grade II* listed building built in 1881. One of the most interesting features in our church is the pulpit, which came from Manchester Cathedral during the Second World War. St Peter's Church is an Austin Palen design. As well as being a beautiful church, we also have a World War I war memorial which is believed to be one of the best in the North West, which is also listed.
