Click on the 'Start' menu (Bottom left hand corner of screen) Then Click **'Computer'.** 






Double click on 'Wigan Libraries WorkClub to open

**TOP TIP:** To avoid losing your work it is recommended that you make a backup copy of your files stored on the USB memory stick. This can be done by attaching documents, such as your CV, to an email and sending this to yourself.
