NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

WIGAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH HAIGH NO. 22 (PART))
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018

The above Order made on 26th October 2018 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert Public Footpath Haigh No. 22 running from the junction with Haigh No. 21 and Aspull No. 1 at a point marked A on the order map in a north easterly direction for approximately 90 metres or thereabouts to a point marked B on the order map and then in a northerly direction for approximately 38 metres to a point marked C on the order map to a new line running from a point marked A on the order map in a north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 83 metres or thereabouts to a point marked D on the order map, then in a south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 15 metres or thereabouts to a point marked B on the order map, then in a north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 12 metres or thereabouts to a point marked E on the order map, before heading in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 36 metres or thereabouts to point C on the order map.

A new public footpath, Haigh No. 22A, will be dedicated. This will run from a point marked E on the order map in a north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 37 metres or thereabouts to a point marked F on the order map.

A copy of the Order and the Order Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.30 pm on any day Monday to Friday. Copies of the Order and Map may be bought there at the price of £1.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Assistant Director Legal at the Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan not later than 7th December 2018. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Wigan Borough Council may, confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
