ASH STREET BRYN - PROHIBITION OF WAITING

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No. 581) Order 2024

The effect of the Order will be to revoke restricted waiting on the following roads at the following times:

Road	Side	From	To	Period of Operation
Ash Street, Bryn	Northwest	Its junction with Wigan Road	For a distance of 15 metres in a south westerly direction	On any day 9am – 6pm
Ash Street, Bryn	South East	Its junction with Wigan Road	For a distance of 26 metres in a south westerly direction	On any day 9am - 6pm

The effect of the Order will be to introduce restricted waiting on any day 9am – 6pm on:

- Ash Street Bryn – both sides from a point 10 metres southwest of its junction with Wigan Road A49 to a point 26 metres southwest of its junction with A49 Wigan Road

The effect of the Order will be to introduce prohibited waiting at any time on:

- Ash Street Bryn – both sides from its junction with Wigan Road A49 to a point 10 metres southwest of its junction with A49 Wigan Road
- A49 Wigan Road Bryn – southwest from a point 15 metres northwest of its junction with Ash Street to a point 15 metres southeast of its junction with Ash Street

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait to enable people to board or alight; for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies and Post Office purposes; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral; to take on fuel, water or air at any garage; for the delivery or collection of goods and for loading or unloading; or the avoidance of an accident.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce restricted loading on any day 9am-6pm on:

- Ash Street Bryn – both sides from a point 10 metres southwest of its junction with Wigan Road A49 to a point 26 metres southwest of its junction with A49 Wigan Road

The effect of the Order will be to introduce prohibited loading at any time on:

- Ash Street Bryn – both sides from its junction with Wigan Road A49 to a point 10 metres southwest of its junction with A49 Wigan Road
- A49 Wigan Road Bryn – southwest from a point 15 metres northwest of its junction with Ash Street to a point 15 metres southeast of its junction with Ash Street

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.
