LEDGARD AVENUE AND WINTERGREEN CLOSE, LEIGH - PRIVILEGED PARKING NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Leigh Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.159) Order 2026.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce privileged parking on the following lengths of road between 5pm to 10pm on Monday to Friday and 10am to 7pm on Saturday and Sunday:

- Ledgard Avenue (Both Sides) from a point 204 metres north of its junction with Sale Way up to and including its cul-de-sac end.
- Wintergreen Close (Both Sides) from its junction with Ledgard Avenue up to and including its cul-de-sac end.

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait to enable people to board or alight; for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; to take on fuel, water or air at any garage; or for the delivery or collection of goods and for loading or unloading.

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.
