NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No. 617) Order 2025.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no waiting at any time on:

- Shuttle Street, Tyldesley (South side) from a point 10 metres east of its junction with Johnson Street to a point 10 metres west of its junction with Primrose Street
- Shuttle Street, Tyldesley (North side) from a point 5 metres east of its junction with Johnson Street to a point 10 metres west of its junction with Primrose Street North
- Shuttle Street, Tyldesley (both sides) from a point 6 metres east of its junction with Primrose Street North to a point 10 metres west of its junction with Milk Street

The effect of the Order will be to revoke restriction of waiting, on Monday-Saturday, 8am-6pm, on:

- Shuttle Street, Tyldesley (south) from a point a 10 metres east of its junction with Johnson Street to a point 10 metres west of its junction with Primrose Street
- Shuttle Street, Tyldesley (north) from a point 5 metres east of its junction with Johnson Street to a point 10 metres west of its junction with Primrose Street North
- Shuttle Street, Tyldesley (both sides) from a point 6 metres east of its junction with Primrose Street North to a point 10 metres west of its junction with Milk Street

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait to enable people to board or alight; for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies and Post Office purposes; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral; to take on fuel, water or air at any garage; for the delivery or collection of goods and for loading or unloading; or the avoidance of an accident.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke the loading bay, Monday-Saturday, 8am-6pm on:

• Elliott Street, Tyldesley (north side) from a point 4 metres east of its junction with Milk Street to a point 22 metres east of its junction with Milk Street

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a loading bay, Monday-Saturday, 8am-6pm, on:

• Elliott Street, Tyldesley (north side) from a point 14 metres east of its junction with Milk Street to for a distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait, for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies and Post Office purposes; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral; or the avoidance of an accident.

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.
