## TURTON STREET AND TALBOT STREET GOLBORNE – REVOCATION OF RESTRICTED WAITING / INTRODUCTION OF PROHIBITED WAITING

## **NOTICE OF PROPOSALS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No. 602) Order 2025.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke restricted waiting on the following roads:

Road	Side	From	То	Period
Turton Street, Golborne	West	A point 10 metres south of its junction with Heath Street	For its entire length	On any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday 8.00am to 6.00pm
Talbot Street, Golborne	Both	Its junction with Turton Street	For a distance of 37 metres in a Westerly direction	On any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday 8.00am-6.00pm

The effect of the Order will be to introduce prohibited waiting at any time on:

- Turton Street Golborne west side from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Heath Street for its entire length.
- Talbot Street Golborne both sides from its junction with Turton Street for a distance of 37 metres in a westerly direction.

There will be limited exceptions for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral; or the avoidance of an accident.

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.
