### **BROXTON AVENUE AND ORRELL ROAD – PROHIBITION OF LOADING**

#### **NOTICE OF PROPOSALS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.629) Order 2026.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce restricted loading on Monday to Friday from 7:30am – 9:30am and 4:30pm – 6:30pm on:

- Orrell Road, Orrell (South) from its junction with Moor Road to a point 44 metres east of its junction with Orrell Gardens.
- Orrell Road, Orrell (North) from its junction with Moor Road to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Broxton Avenue.
- Orrell Road, Orrell (North) from a point 10 metres east of its junction with Broxton Avenue to a point 44 metres east of its junction with Orrell Gardens.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no loading at any time on:

- Orrell Road, Orrell (North) from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Broxton Avenue to a point 10 metres east of its junction with Broxton Avenue.
- Broxton Avenue, Orrell (Both sides) from its junction with Orrell Road to a point 15 metres north of its junction with Orrell Road.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke restricted loading on Monday to Friday at the times specified below on:

- Orrell Road, Orrell (Both sides) from its junction with Moor Road to a point 44 metres east of its junction with Orrell Gardens between 7:30am – 9:30am and 4:30pm – 6:30pm.
- Broxton Avenue, Orrell (Both sides) from its junction with Orrell Road for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction between 7:30am – 9:30am and 4:00pm – 6:30pm.

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.
