MARKET STREET, ATHERTON – VARIOUS ROAD TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.627) Order 2026.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke no waiting at any time on:

- Market Street, Atherton (both sides) from its junction with Market Place to its junction with Leigh Road

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no waiting at any time on:

- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from its junction with St Johns Street to a point 29 metres east of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 8 metres east of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 5 metres west of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 25 metres west of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 5 metres west of its junction with Smith Street
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 7 metres east of its junction with Hampson Street to a point 9 metres west of its junction with Hampson Street
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 27 metres west of its junction with Hampson Street to a point 34 metres west of its junction with Hampson Street
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 9 metres east of its junction with Bag Lane to a point 18 metres west of its junction with Bag Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 7 metres east of its junction with Sumner Street to its junction with Leigh Road
- Market Street, Atherton (south side) from a point 21 metres east of its junction with Crab Tree Lane for a distance of 45 metres in a west bound direction
- Market Street, Atherton (south) from a point 46 metres east of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 34 metres east of its junction with Smith Street
- Market Street, Atherton (south side) to a point 9 metres east of its junction with Smith Street to its junction with Leigh Road

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no waiting, Monday – Saturday, 8am – 6pm:

- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 29 metres east of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 8 metres east of its junction with Flapper Folder Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 25 metres west of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Smith Street to a point 42 metres west of its junction with Smith Street
- Market Street, Atherton (south side) from a point 34 metres east of its junction with Smith Street to a point 9 metres west of its junction with Smith Street

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait to enable people to board or alight; for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies and Post Office purposes; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral; to

take on fuel, water or air at any garage; for the delivery or collection of goods and for loading or unloading; or the avoidance of an accident.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no loading / unloading, at any time on:

- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from its junction with St Johns Street to a point 28 metres east of its junction with Flapper Folder Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 8 metres east of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 5 metres west of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 25 metres west of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 5 metres west of its junction with Smith Street
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 6 metres east of its junction with Hampson Street to a point 9 metres west of its junction with Hampson Street
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 27 metres west of its junction with Hampson Street to a point 34 metres west of its junction with Hampson Street
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 9 metres east of its junction with Bag Lane to a point 18 metres west of its junction with Bag Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (south side) from a point 21 metres east of its junction with Crab Tree Lane for a distance of 45 metres in a west bound direction
- Market Street, Atherton (south side) from a point 46 metres east of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 34 metres east of its junction with Smith Street
- Market Street, Atherton (south side) from a point 9 metres east of its junction with Smith Street to a point 35 metres west of its junction with Bullough Street

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no loading / unloading, Monday – Saturday 10:30am – 4pm:

- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 29 metres east of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 8 metres east of its junction with Flapper Folder Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane to a point 25 metres west of its junction with Flapper Fold Lane
- Market Street, Atherton (north side) from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Smith Street to a point 42 metres west of its junction with Smith Street
- Market Street, Atherton (south side) from a point 34 metres east of its junction with Smith Street to a point 9 metres west of its junction with Smith Street

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.
