OLD ROAD AND LOW BANK ROAD, ASHTON-IN-MAKERFIELD – PROPOSED SPEED RESTRICTION

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 82(2), 83(2) and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and all other enabling powers, proposes to make the Wigan Borough Council (Old Road and Low Bank Road, Ashton-in-Makerfield) (20 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2026.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke a speed limit of 20 miles per hour, on the following road:

- Old Road, Ashton-in-Makerfield from its junction with Bryn Street for a distance of 23 metres in a westerly direction.

The effect of the Order will be to impose a speed limit of 20 miles per hour, on the following roads:

- Old Road, Ashton-in-Makerfield from its junction with the A49 Wigan Road to its junction with the A5062 Wigan Road.
- Mayfield Street, Ashton-in-Makerfield from its junction with Old Road to the point at which the road terminates.
- Low Bank Road, Ashton-in-Makerfield from its junction with Old Road to a point 5 metres west of its junction with Balliol Way.
