OLD ROAD AND OSBORNE ROAD, ASHTON-IN-MAKERFIELD – PROHIBITION OF LOADING

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.622) Order 2026.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no loading at any time on:

- Old Road, Ashton-in-Makerfield (North East) from a point 15 metres northwest of its junction with Osborne Road to its junction with Osborne Road.
- Osborne Road, Ashton-in-Makerfield (Both sides) from its junction with Old Road to a point 10 metres northeast of its junction with Old Road.

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.
