

**WIGAN BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**CARR LANE, WORSLEY MESNES – VARIOUS ROAD ACTS**  
**NOTICE OF PROPOSALS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads No. 2) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.105) Order 2019

The effect of the Order will be to revoke no waiting at any time on:

- Wellham Road (South East side) from its junction with Carr Lane to a point 64.5 metres north east of its junction with Carr Lane
- Carr Lane, Wigan (North East side) from its junction with Wellham Road to a point 40.5m south east of its junction with Wellham Road
- Unnamed carriageway between Carr Lane and Wellham Road (Both sides) from its junction with Carr Lane to its junction with Wellham Road

The effect of the order will be to introduce no waiting at any time on:

- Wellham Road (South East side) from a point 48.5 metres north east of its junction with Carr Lane to a point 65.6 metres north east of its junction with Carr Lane
- Unnamed carriageway between Carr Lane and Wellham Road (East side) from a point 50.5 metres north of its junction with Carr Lane to its northern extent

The effect of the order will be to introduce no waiting on the following lengths of road between the times and on the days specified below:

- Wellham Road (South East side) from its junction with Carr Lane to a point 37.5 metres north east of its junction with Carr Lane Monday to Friday 8.00 to 9.00am 2.30 to 3.30pm
- Carr Lane (North East side) from its junction with Wellham Road to a point 40.5m south east of its junction with Wellham Road Monday to Friday 8.00 to 9.00am 2.30 to 3.30pm
- Unnamed carriageway between Carr Lane and Wellham Road (West side) from its junction with Carr Lane to its junction with Wellham Road Monday to Friday 8.00 to 9.00am 2.30 to 3.30pm
- Unnamed carriageway between Carr Lane and Wellham Road (East side) from its junction with Carr Lane to a point 13m north of its junction with Carr Lane Monday to Friday 8.00 to 9.00am 2.30 to 3.30pm

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait to enable people to board or alight; for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies and Post Office purposes; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral; to take on fuel, water or air at any garage; for the delivery or collection of goods and for loading or unloading; or the avoidance of an accident.

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.

A copy of the proposed Order, the Order to be amended, and of the relevant map and of a statement of the reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan, between 9.00am and 4.30pm on any day from Monday to Friday.

Any objection to the Order must be made in writing and specify the grounds thereof and must be made to the Assistant Director Legal, Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan quoting reference RD/LS/ RD/LS/DZB/CL48.609 not later than 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2019.
