**CHURCH DRIVE ORRELL - PROHIBITION OF WAITING ORDER 2021**

**NOTICE OF PROPOSALS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.517) Order 2021

The effect of the Order will be to revoke restricted waiting on the following roads at any time:

- Church Drive Orrell – both sides from its junction with Church Street for a distance of 15 metres in a south westerly direction

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no waiting at any time on:

- Church Drive Orrell – south side from its junction with Church Street to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Church Street
- Church Drive Orrell – north side from its junction with Church Street to a point 45 metres west of its junction with Church Street

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait to enable people to board or alight; for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies and Post Office purposes; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral; to take on fuel, water or air at any garage; for the delivery or collection of goods and for loading or unloading; or the avoidance of an accident.

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.

Any objection to the Order must be made in writing and specify the grounds thereof and must be made to the Assistant Director Legal, Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan quoting reference RD/LS/DC/C108/278 not later than 24<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
