**HIGH PARK, SHEVINGTON – EXPERIMENTAL PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AT SCHOOL ENTRANCES**

**NOTICE OF MAKING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Traffic Management Act 2004, of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, has made the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation Order) 2004 (Amendment No.505) (Experimental) Order 2020 which will come into operation on 25<sup>th</sup> November 2020.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce, for an experimental period of 18 months, no stopping at school entrances on:-

- High Park, Shevington (West Side) from a point 20 metres south of Yewdale to a point 50 metres south of Yewdale.

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait –

Removing obstructions to traffic; road works and works by statutory undertakers; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or for repairs of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water electricity or any telecommunication apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** Wigan Borough Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person may within the period of six months from the coming into force of this Order, object to the making of the Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation. Any such objections to the Order must be made in writing and specify the grounds thereof and must be made to the Assistant Director - Legal, Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan quoting reference RD/LS/SEC/C108.160 not later than 25<sup>th</sup> May 2021.
