**NOTICE OF PROPOSALS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.144) Order 2019.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke, Disabled Person Parking Space on:

Library Street, Wigan	North	A point 63 metres east of its junction with Hewlett Street	A point 92 metres east of its junction with Hewlett Street	180	60	On any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday 8.00 am to 6.00 pm

The effect of the Order will be to introduce, Disabled Person Parking Space on:

<b>Road</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>From</b>	<b>To</b>	<b>Waiting Limited (Mins)</b>	<b>Return Prohibited Within (Mins)</b>	<b>Period of Operation</b>
Library Street, Wigan	North	A point 63 metres east of its junction with Hewlett Street	A point 92 metres east of its junction with Hewlett Street	180	60	At any time

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait -

For the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies and if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral.

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.

A copy of the proposed Order, the Order to be amended, and of the relevant map and a statement of the reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan, between 9am and 4:30pm on any day from Monday to Friday.

Any objection to the Order must be made in writing and specify the grounds thereof and must be made to the Assistant Director - Legal, Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan quoting reference RD/LS/SEC/CL48.603 not later than 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019.
