

**WIGAN BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**POOLSTOCK, WORSLEY MESNES – EXPERIMENTAL VARIOUS ROAD ACTS**  
**NOTICE OF MAKING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 9 and 10 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, has made the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Wigan Roads No. 2) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.115) Experimental Order 2021 which will come into operation on 5<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke for an experimental period of 18 months, no waiting at any time on:-

- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (North Side) from a point 14 metres east of Grange Avenue to a point 15 metres west of Grange Avenue.
- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (North Side) from a point 16 metres east of Holborn Avenue to a point 15 metres west of Holborn Avenue.
- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (North Side) from a point 67 metres west of St. Paul's Avenue to a point 30 metres east of Worsley Mesnes Drive.
- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (South Side) from a point 67 metres west of St. Paul's Avenue to a point 86 metres east of Carr Lane.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke for an experimental period of 18 months, no loading/unloading on:-

- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (North Side) from a point 82 metres east of Carr Lane to a point 30 metres east of Worsley Mesnes Drive on any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday 7.30am - 9.30am and 4.00pm - 6.30pm.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce for an experimental period of 18 months, no waiting at any time on:-

- Pool Street, Douglas (East Side) from its junction with Poolstock to a point 20 metres north of its junction with Church Street.
- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (North West Side) from a point 14 metres north east of its junction with Grange Avenue to a point 19.5 metres south west of its junction with Grange Avenue.
- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (North West Side) from a point 9 metres north east of its junction with Holborn Avenue to a point 8 metres south west of its junction with Holborn Avenue.
- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (North West Side) from a point 77 metres south west of St. Paul's Avenue to a point 5 metres north east of Worsley Mesnes Drive.
- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (South East Side) from a point 67 metres south west of Carr Lane to a point 61 metres north east of Carr Lane.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce for an experimental period of 18 months, no loading/unloading on:-

- Poolstock Lane, Wigan (North West Side) from its junction with St. Paul's Avenue to a point 5 metres north east of Worsley Mesnes Drive on any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday 7.30am - 9.30am and 4.00pm - 6.30pm

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait to enable people to board or alight; for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies and Post Office purposes; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral; to take on fuel, water or air at any garage; for the delivery or collection of goods and for loading or unloading; or the avoidance of an accident.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 9 and 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004, has made the Wigan Borough Council (Poolstock, Worsley Mesnes) (20 MPH Speed Restriction) Experimental Order 2021 which will come into operation on 5<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce 20mph speed restriction for an experimental period of 18 months on:-

- Pool Street, Douglas from a point 27 metres north of its junction with Park Street to its junction with Poolstock.
- Poolstock, Wigan from its junction with Corporation Street to its junction with Poolstock Lane.
- Poolstock Lane, Wigan from its junction with Poolstock to a point 50 metres north east of its junction with Warrington Road.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN Wigan Borough Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person may within the period of six months from the coming into force of this Order object to the making of the Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation. Any such objections to the Order must be made in writing and specify the grounds thereof and must be made to the Assistant Director - Legal, Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan quoting reference RD/LS/DZB/C108.188 not later than 12<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
